**Tuesday, April 16<sup>th</sup>, Tulip Festival, Skagit Valley:** Gaze across the astoundingly beautiful tulip fields! We will visit both Tulip Town and RoozenGaarde again this year (entrance fees included.) Tulip Town has been open to the public for 35 years! In order to save time and allow us to visit both gardens, we will be skipping a stop for lunch. You can choose to either bring your own lunch or enjoy one of the food vendor options at either garden on your own. (Food options vary.) ***This one fills up fast!*** Includes tickets. **Call now! **Thursday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, Museums at Fort Warden:** We will go to the **Puget Sound Coast Artillery Museum and the Commanding Officers Quarters (tour).** There is also the **Port Townsend School of Woodworking & Preservation Trades**; you have the opportunity to stop by and check out what they have to offer. For lunch, we will try the Doc’s Marina Grill at the harbor (on your own). If you would rather not go to the museums, you can walk about the town...Port Townsend is great for shopping and exploring!

**Wednesday, April 24: Tacoma Art Museum:** You will not only see some Chihuly glass pieces displayed, but there are also several other exhibits at the **Tacoma Art Museum.** If you would like to go to the History Museum and the Museum of Glass also, **PLEASE** let me know ahead of time, as you can purchase tickets for all three and receive a discount. You will find many special cafes for lunch, or bring a box lunch! Price includes art museum only. **Departs 8:30 a.m. Est. Return 6:00 p.m. \$48 M / \$53 NM**

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**Tuesday, April 30: Whitney's Gardens and Nursery:** Rhododendrons begin blooming in February and the peak bloom of fragrant rhododendrons is in early May. Check out the beautiful Oaks, Maples, Magnolias, Beeches, Plums, Katsuras and many colorful deciduous shrubs and companion plants. Stroll along a half mile of sand and gravel pathways through level and gently sloping terrain (wheelchair accessible). See the trees determined by the University of Washington Department of Horticulture to be the oldest living specimens of its species in the state. Benches and tables provided for picnics. Ask about a Shipley Box lunch for an additional \$8.00!

Museum and other interesting spots in town. Dinner on your own; we will stay at the Quality Inn. After breakfast, we will bus you over to **Beamers**

**Hells Canyon Tours.** We'll be going on a 4 or 5 hour tour, including a stop at a resort for lunch of fried chicken, salad, buttermilk rolls, and cold drink of choice. After the river tour, onward to Walla Walla. Our driver, John, will take you to a few wineries, if you like; dinner to follow (on your own).

Friday morning we will be heading home to Sequim with a few stops along the way. We should arrive home around 6:00 p.m. Activity Level = 3-4
