Stroll along a half mile of sand and gravel pathways through level and gently sloping terrain (wheelchair accessible). See the trees determined by the University of Washington Department of Horticulture to be the oldest living specimens of its species in the state. Benches and tables provided for picnics. **Thursday, May 23: Heronswood Gardens and Nursery:** In 2012, the Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe purchased Heronswood at auction, and the rebirth and revealing of the now overgrown landscape began. Though many of the original plants that comprised the garden were lost during the period of neglect, many important collections have been recovered, while an exciting inventory of new plants from China, Vietnam, Chile, Myanmar, New Zealand and Tasmania—are already settled into their new home. The current staff of Heronswood Garden and the managing Port Gamble S'Klallam Foundation are committed to making Heronswood a botanical wonderland. We will also go to Central Market in Poulsbo (for lunch) and Valley Nursery

**Friday, May 31, Wolf Haven, Tenino, WA:** Its been a few years since we visited this sanctuary. The Wolf Recovery presentation talks about what happened to the wolves in WA and the US, and how they are coming back. This is a wonderful time of year to go. There are gravel paths. Tour is ¼ mile at a good pace, wear good shoes and bring your camera! Lunch at Scotty B's, a 50's restaurant nearby (around 1:00).

Wine country, Eastern Washington, and a Snake River adventure!
